Over 50% of organizations believe they are somewhat prepared when it comes to BCP and remote working

Businesses say below are the **most important elements** to a BCP:

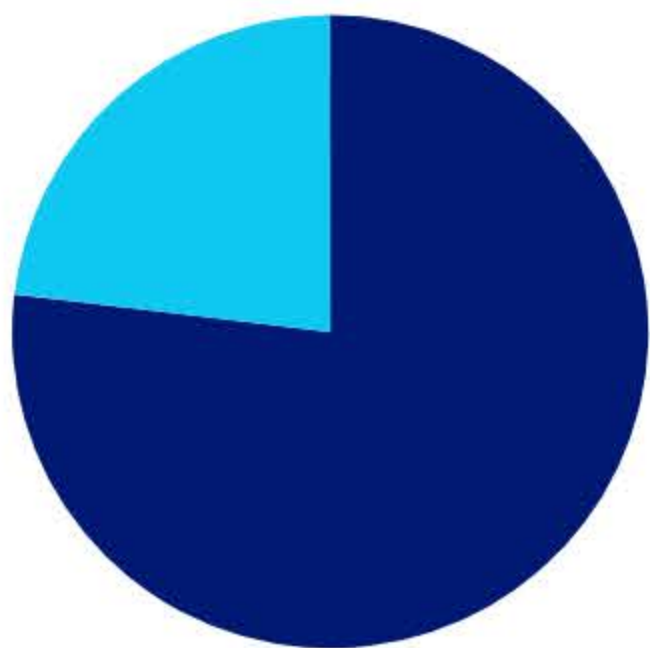
